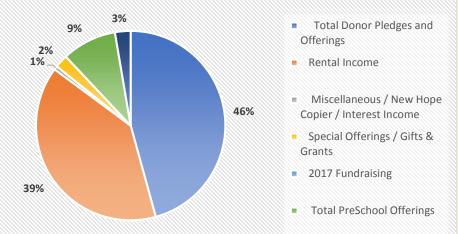

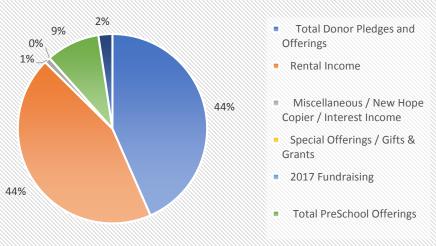

Celebrating our Financial Successes

Pledge Income and Loose Plate income grew 11% from 2016 (\$197K) – 2017 (\$220K)

Our Preschool nearly doubled in size from 2016-17 to 2017-18 school year and is now contributing towards the operational expenses of the parish.

We closed out 2017 with all our bills being paid.

Contributions to our Community Outreach Ministries exceeded over \$12,000 from our members.

Awarded the Bishop Lee Grant for Church Revitalization for use with our Capital Improvements.

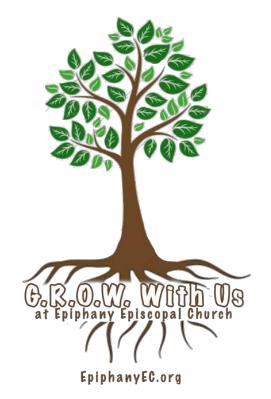

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Attended diocesan workshop on Stewardship
- Worked with vestry to determine theme and goals for the 2018 giving campaign.
- Planned Ministry Moments at services to encourage giving by highlighting the outstanding work of Epiphany ministries in the life of the parish.
- Vestry pledge letters mailed,
- Kick off Letter mailed to parishioners
- Pledge packets prepared: 30 picked up at church, 93 mailed.
- Campaign Kickoff—October 25—Ministry Speed Dating
- Sharing Sunday—November 12 First pledges received. (Continuing to accept pledges until we meet our goal.)



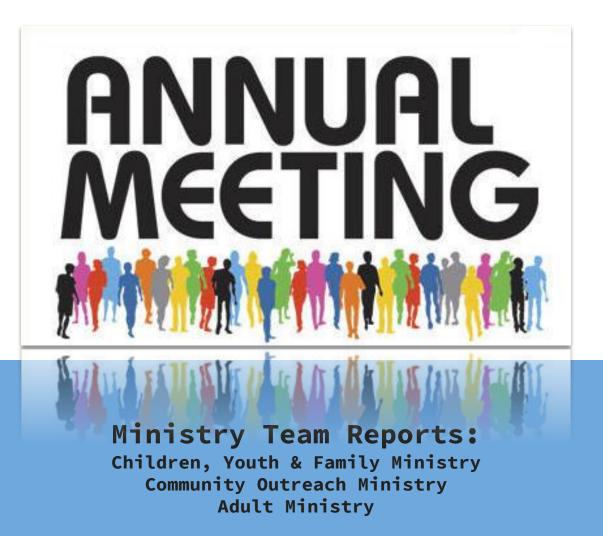
RESULTS to date

- 58 pledges totaling \$ \$199,928.
- Compared to 2017 of 42 pledges totaling \$195,186, we are ahead 16 pledges and \$4,742 dollars.
- 48% parish participation, 100% vestry participation.

REMAINING WORK

- Continue to work towards our goal of 100% giving.
- Support Epiphany ministries to fully fund their 2018 budget requests, and reverse current constraints required.

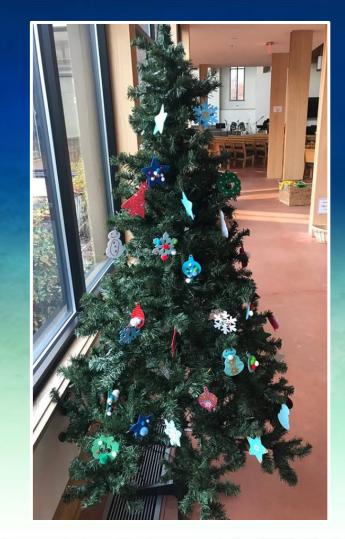
















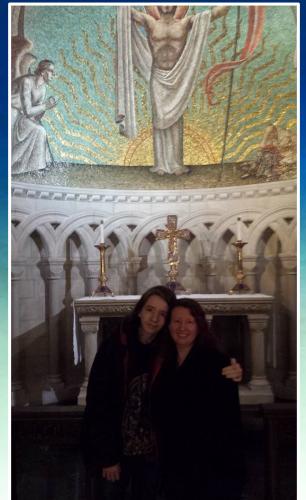

Outreach 2017 by the Numbers

- Money spent: ~\$23,500
- Hypothermia Shelter: average 35 guests/night hosted with the help of ~85 volunteers
- Pack-a-Thon: 14,000 meals packed
- Hot Meals: 4 events with average 87 meals served
- Food4Thought : 12 packing events for Fairfax County school kids
- Food Pantry : co-funded 52 food packages distribution events for the needy

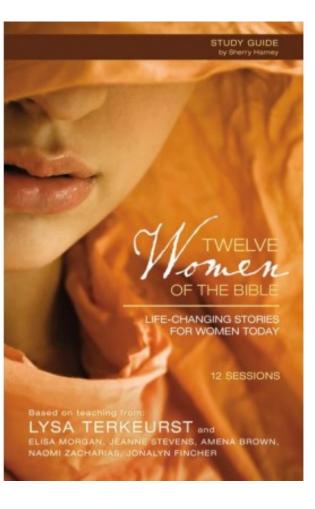

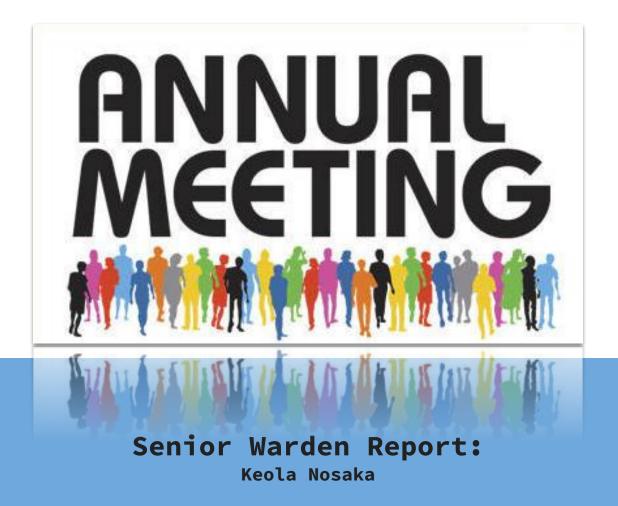


Plan to Thrive in 2018

- Need additional members to join ministry to help facilitate the diverse offerings.



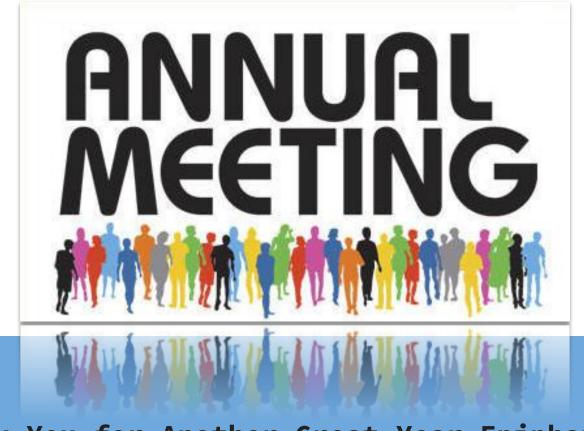
