Call to Order

Rev. Widlake called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Rev Widlake presented the Clergy Report.

Kathleen Bellis resigned as Vestry member. A replacement is being sought to finish out her term.

Rev Widlake suggested that Vestry members plan ahead and begin to identify potential future members.

Nadia suggested a post with a description of Vestry duties might be helpful.

Rev Widlake suggested all read the Vestry reports to be caught up on what's happening.

Rev Widlake reviewed pastoral notes with the Vestry members.

Staff retreat July 25.

Worship: we have a framework for the next liturgical year.

Rev will be meeting with Senior Director of Facets to confirm affiliation, and establish vision of way forward. Did you know Hot Meals is a FACET affiliated Outreach?

Transition of monthly Celtic service to Contemplative service has gone well. May talk to Art and Sally about moving it to 7 pm and to the first Sunday of the month.

Family service will use baptismal vows in place of Nicene Creed through the end of the year.

Rev Widlake will go next week to deliver Hot Meals food.

We are expanding the use of REALM and using them for newcomers, and who needs to receive the sacraments from church.

Art & Rev Widlake are meeting to capture the story of Epiphany, and be sure to check the Wikipedia page and update it as necessary.

New preschool director, Sue is up and has started. She had a smooth transition with Gayle, and has been advertising positions and conducting interviews. She expects this year's enrollment will be less than 50, and will meet with Keola to adjust budget.

For VPOD, it was suggested that the 3 remaining Vestry members be supplemented in VPOD duties with a volunteer of the day.

Rev Widlake will meet with Nadia and Laurel Musson Wednesday 7/20 to discuss the various Worship team ministries and a strategy for inviting people into them

Save the Stream campaign has raised enough for a computer so far, now looking to raise enough for a camera.

Cameron asked for an Employee Retention Credit (ERC) update. ERC is done. All eligible payroll (941) tax forms have been amended and submitted to the government. We were eligible for 5 quarters, 5 different checks, totaling over \$143K.

Drainage project is moving along. System intact, just needs blowing out.
